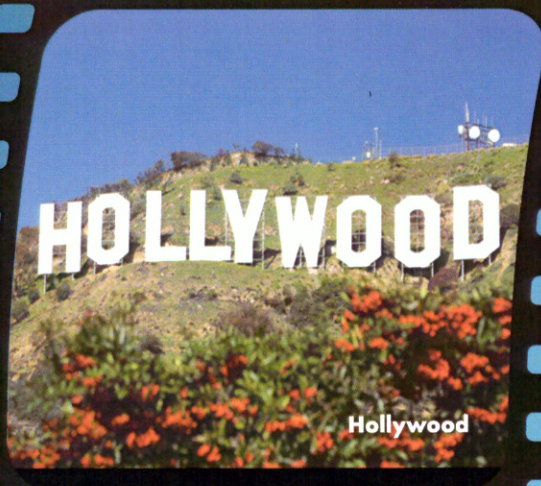

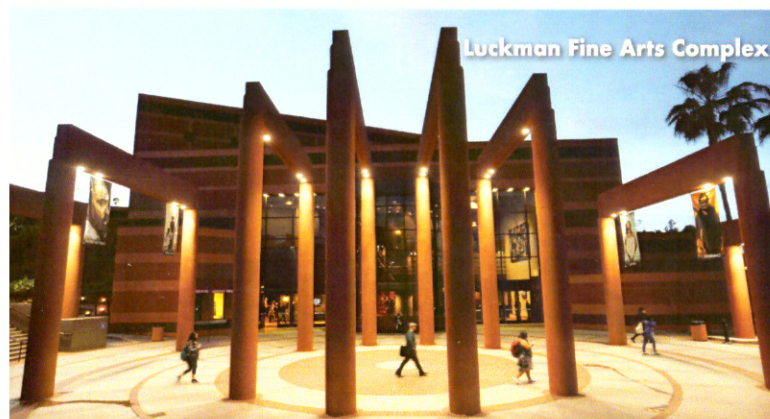

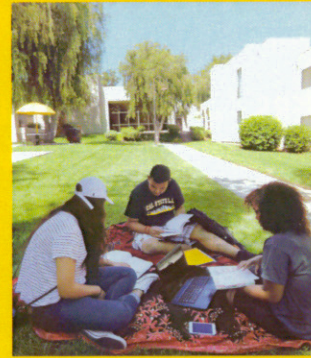


HOUSING
