ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Proof of high-level English-language skills is required to participate in university courses. The American Language and Cultural Institute at CSUSM accepts the following as proof of academic English ability:

- TOEFL score of 61 (minimum score of 19 in writing, and 14 on all other sections)
- IELTS score of 5.5 (with a 5.5 in writing, and 5.0 on all other scores)
- DAAD level B2
- Other proof of language proficiency, please submit with application for review.

Minimum of 2.0 GPA (US scale)

Must be 18 years old and a high school graduate

HOW TO APPLY

Complete and collect the following documents:

- A completed fillable, Study @ CSU San Marcos Application form (download the application to your computer before filling it out)
- An original bank statement dated within the past six months or a scholarship or sponsor letter (minimum of \$19,502)
- A scanned photocopy of your passport
- Transcripts in English and list of courses you are currently taking (minimum GPA of 2.0)
- Unofficial TOEFL, IELTS, DAAD or other proof of language proficiency for review
