ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

This application has several phases. To participate in a UCLA Extension International Study Abroad program, each step must be completed in its entirety by the mandated deadlines.

The International Program Fee is 3850\$ for the first quarter of study and 2850\$ for each subsequent quarter you continue to study with UCLA Extension.

First Quarter

The first quarter International Program Fee is charged in two phases: The Program Deposit (500\$) and the Programm Fee Balance (3350\$).

Stage 1: 500\$ non-refundable program deposit due upon acceptance into the program. The deposit must be received within 2 weeks of your admission date.

Stage 2: The balance of 3350\$ is due at least 30 days before the quarter start date. Failure to pay your fees before the stated deadline will result in the automatic cancellation of your admission to the program and Form I-20.

Subsequent Quarters

The International Program Fee is 2850\$ for each subsequent quarter of study at UCLA Extension. The fee is due at least 30 days before each quarter start date. Failure to pay your fees before the stated deadline will result in the automatic cancellation of your admission into the program.

FINANCIAL CERTIFICATION GUIDELINES

You and/or your sponsor are financially responsible for your educational and living expenses for the duration of your educational program as well as for the educational and/or living expenses of your husband, wife, and/or children who will accompany you. All students and sponsors must provide financial certification that they are financially capable of meeting the minimum funds required for this program. Minimum funds required can be found using the table listed below. Additionally, UCLA Extension may share information from your academic record with your financial sponsor.

We will accept a bank endorsement in the form of an original letter from the bank with a bank seal dated **within the last 60 days**, on official bank stationary in English. All financial verifications must state the minimum amounts and be for liquid accounts.

If a sponsor will be paying for you, please provide either an affadavit of support or letter of sponsorship, signed and dated **within the last 60 days**, which states the amount of financial support and the relationship to the student. If accompanied by family, additional amounts must also be available.

If the funds are outside the United States, the applicant must be permitted to use them under his/her government's present regulations. All funds must be available for transfer to the United States.

CANCELLATION, REFUND, DEFERRAL, AND TRANSFER POLICY

Please read the following carefully!

All cancellation, refund, deferral, and transfer requests must be submitted on UCLA Extension American Language Center (ALC) 'Study Abroad at UCLA Cancellation, Refund, Deferral, and Transfer Request Form' and are subject to approval by ALC management. If payment was made by credit card, a credit will appear on the same credit card used (allow 3-5 weeks for processing). If payment was made by check, cash, or bank wire transfer, a refund check will be issued (allow 6-8 weeks for processing). There is a \$30 processing fee for each refund issued; this fee is subject to change.

A. Nonrefundable Application Fee

All application fees must be paid before submitting the application. The Study Abroad at UCLA program application fees are nonrefundable.

B. Cancelling Prior to Arrival in the U.S.

Students who cancel prior to arrival in the U.S. must submit a "Study Abroad at UCLA Cancellation, Refund, Deferral, and Transfer Request Form" 1 week before the quarter start date and return their official documents to ALC.

Full refunds, minus the \$30 processing fee, may be made to students who have been denied a student (F-1) visa. A visa denial letter is required if refund is requested due to the visa denial and if the request is submitted after the program start date. Students must submit a "Study Abroad at UCLA Cancellation, Refund, Deferral, and Transfer Request Form" and return their official documents by Monday of the second week of the quarter.

Refund requests received after the deadlines above will be denied. Additionally, refunds are not processed until all requested items are submitted.

C. Deferring Prior to Arrival in the U.S.

To defer enrollment, students must submit a "Study Abroad at UCLA Cancellation, Refund, Deferral, and Transfer Request Form" with their official documents on or before the Friday of the first week of the quarter start date. A new application also must be submitted at this time with a new start quarter. If all required documents are submitted, ALC can transfer the

original payment to an available future quarter. A \$125 quarter deferral fee will be deducted if a deferral request is received after the program start date.

D. Cancelling After Arrival in the U.S.

Refund requests may be made prior to the end of the second week of instruction. In addition to the nonrefundable application fee, a minimum administrative fee of \$50 per class will be withheld from all refunds. UCLA academic departments may also withhold additional fees for laboratory, material, or department costs. No refund will be granted if students enter the U.S. with government documents indicating that they plan to participate in Study Abroad at UCLA and do not attend.

If a student's I-20 form expires through no fault of UCLA Extension, a refund will not be issued.

E. Transferring to Another School

If you plan to transfer to another school after completing Study Abroad, please contact the UCLA Extension International Student Office (ISO).

If you plan to transfer to another school instead of attending Study Abroad, you will need to fill out a "Study Abroad at UCLA Cancellation, Refund, Deferral, and Transfer Request Form" and refer to section D above regarding the refund. Then contact the ISO regarding transfer to another school.

STUDENT TERMS OF AGREEMENT
